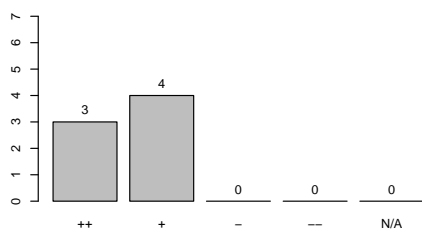

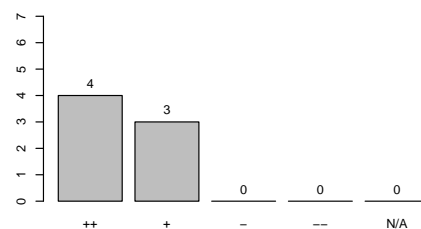

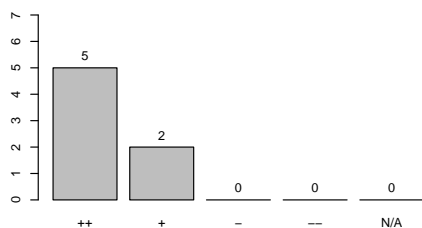
Structural ordering of topics (golden thread)



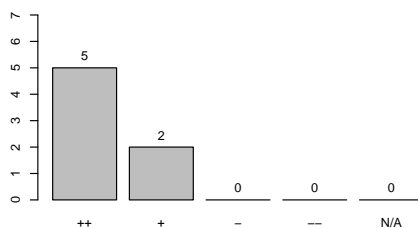

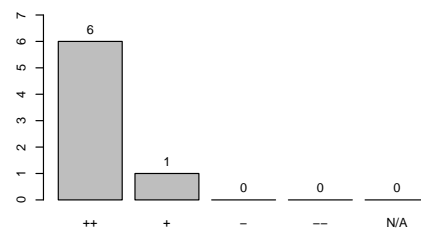

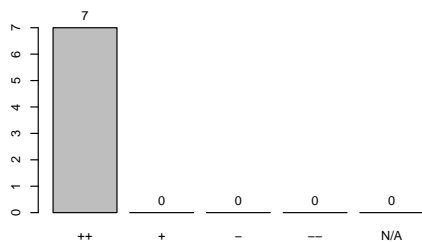

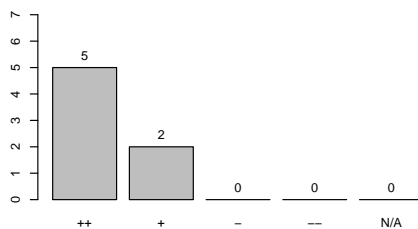

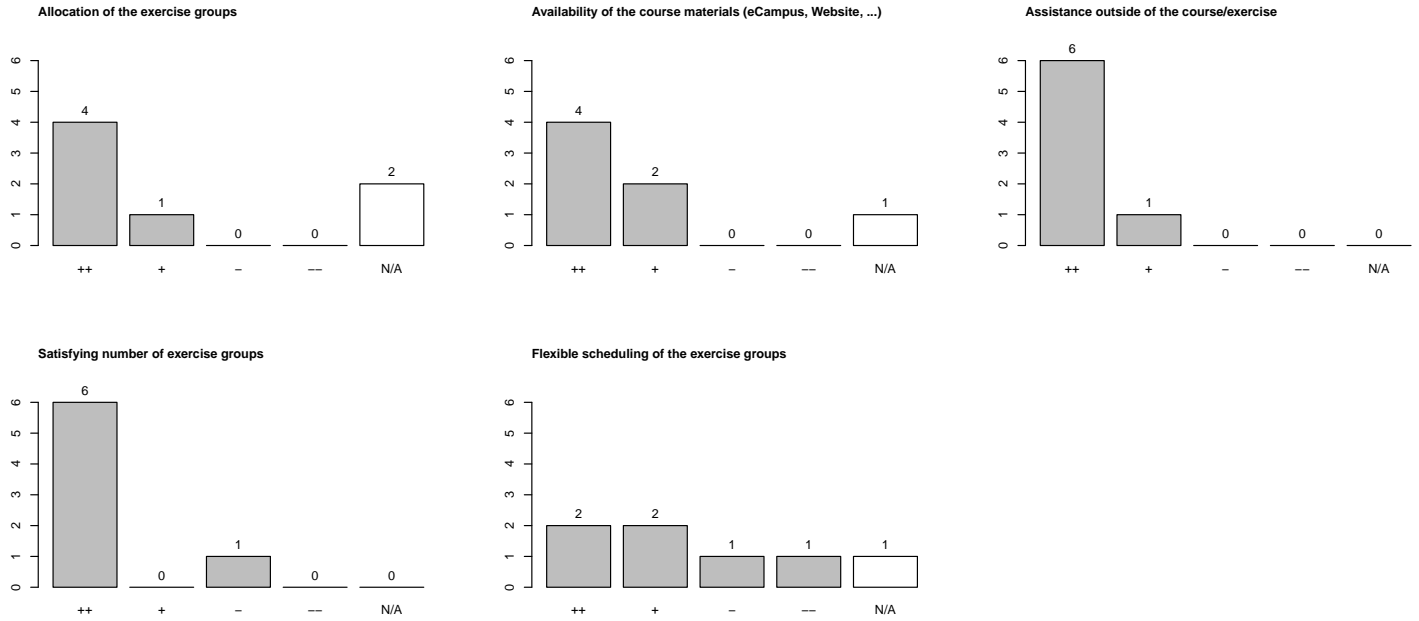
