I often had the feeling in this course that none of what we are learning has any applications in industry.

In this lecture I felt like everything I learned was super dumbed down. If you want to simplify proofs so much that the proven statement becomes a lot weaker, at least tell me about some results (without proof) that the research is currently dealing with. This made the module feel very far away from cutting edge research.

I have no idea. I feel that the topics fit well in the module.

The only thing I think could be enhanced is how the information is explained, specifically regarding the intuition behind the proofs. Sometimes, I feel we get the theorems and results immediately without seeing the logical path of how the author actually arrived there. Seeing that logical journey is what helps us really learn and apply those similar ideas to other areas and algorithms. I understand that lecture time is limited and we can't cover everything, but sometimes the notes just present "Theorem -> Proof," which gives me no idea how I could have reached that result myself. Keeping this in mind would be very helpful.

Another thing I want to mention is the exercises. I feel they could have additional questions (even as bonuses) that are actual problems to solve, rather than just exercises. Since the current ones are usually just applications of the proofs from the lecture, having tougher problems would help us train our problem-solving abilities further.

I would love more interactivity in the lecture. Taking part in finding the solution to a problem helps me understand the content better. But that might just be personal preference, so not meant as criticism!

I think the lecture needs more structure ("roter Faden"). It is clear that the lecturer cares about providing examples and explaining the contents in the most approachable way possible. Still, I had a hard time following the contents of the lecture and understanding the whys and hows of it all.

I think that's because some concepts weren't explained clearly enough before getting into the details of a given proof or algorithm. In my opinion, more care should be put into stating the problem setting precisely and providing an understanding of how it works; often times, there were some general and abstract explanations given on what the next step would be or why a certain approach makes sense, but for me that sometimes wasn't very helpful in order to follow the actual statements and proofs. Maybe it would help to be more clear on a formal level (w.r.t. notation and context), and to be more particular about when and how to give an intuition as well.

Another small addition: it would be cool to provide the number of theorems etc in the lecture as well. If they are given the same number on the board as in the lecture notes, it makes it easier to refer to them and find them afterwards :) Otherwise you end up with a lot of "proof of theorem" and "proof of previous lemma about [...]"
